CONTEST FORMAT

1. REGISTRATION: Registration opens 30 minutes prior to Session start time

Each Group must Register and provide a photocopy of your performance music noting

'Adjudicators Copy Only' and your 'Performance Number'

2. WARM UP TIME: Prior to your Session start there is an area allocated to tune instruments, warm up and prepare

3. SESSION START: All Groups must be SEATED in the audience PRIOR to SESSION START time

4. CALL TO PERFORM: When it is your turn to perform, the Announcer will invite you to come forward to SET UP your

chairs, music stands & instruments before beginning your performance.

Please bring your own support crew to help ensure efficient set up as we are unable to provide

assistance

5. INTRODUCTION: Please announce your; 1. Group name 2. School 3. Title of piece

PLEASE NOTE: Performance time is not to exceed 4 minutes (ONE PIECE ONLY)

6. AFTER PERFORMING: Please return to your seats to enjoy the rest of the Session

7. CERTIFICATES: Award Certificates will be presented at the end of each Session

ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

- Each performance will be commented on in a way that will provide useful feedback for enhancing performance
- Adjudicators will be assessing:
 Stage presentation, performance related to experience, technique, interpretation, dynamics and musicality
- Gold, Silver and Bronze will be made following each session
- · Performers 'Adjudicator Report Sheets' will be made available at the end of each session



RULES & GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. All entrants in the LEJMC must be of Primary or Intermediate School age ie; up to year 8
- 2. Performance time is not to exceed 4 minutes (one piece only)
- 3. Warm up & tune instruments (in allocated area) prior to your session start time
- 4. Performers must be ready and seated at the venue prior to the session start time
- 5. Provide a photocopy of the performance music (hand in at time of registration, if not included with Entry Form). Clearly mark with "Adjudicators Copy Only & Group Performance Number"
- 6. Important Copyright Notice: Any copies of music made for the Adjudicators will be withheld by the LEJMC and destroyed at the conclusion of the Contest
- 7. The Contest Programme will be available online (www.lect.co.nz) NB: your session start time and performance number
- 8. Session start times and approximate session breaks will be indicated on the programme and the utmost effort will be made to adhere to these times
- 9. Overall assessment and awards of Gold, Silver and Bronze will be made following each session
- 10. Performers 'Adjudicator Report Sheets' will be made available at the end of each session
- 11. Any unclaimed awards, report sheets and original music, along with any lost property will be held for collection from Lewis Eady Ltd for one month following the contest
- 12. Awards will be uploaded onto the LECT web site www.lect.co.nz/lejmc
